

3.3 ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

- 3.3.1 The directors, management and staff of Pennine Instrument Services Ltd are committed to the care of the environment and the prevention of pollution.
- 3.3.2 The Company ensures that all its activities are carried out in accordance with the controlled environmental procedures within the BS EN ISO 9001:2008 quality systems.
